Centre Stage Tour

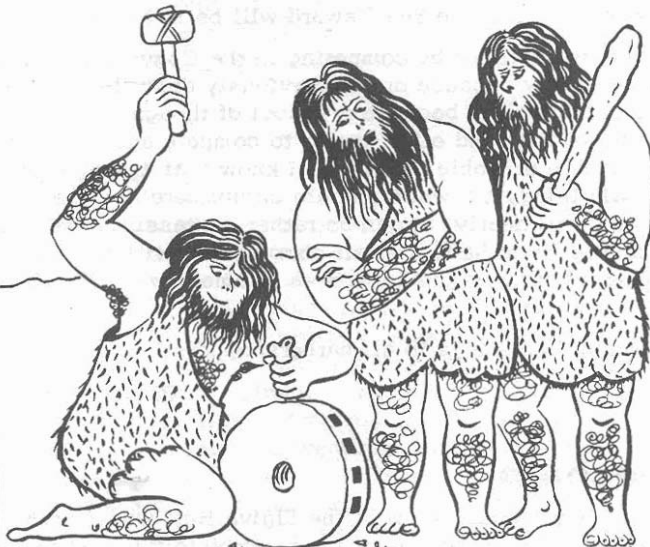
